Vectare are delighted to announce the launch of a new service, numbered 93, that will operate between Grantham and Bingham via Barrowby Gate from Monday 22nd June 2020.

This service will reinstate vital links from the Barrowby Gate estate to shopping and healthcare facilities, lost with the suspension of Centrebus service 3. It will also open up new links between Bingham and Grantham. In Bingham, connections will be available onto Trent Barton services which run direct into Nottingham, as well as Vectare (NottsBus) service 833 for travel to Orston, Langar, Cropwell Bishop and other villages in the Vale of Belvoir. In Grantham town centre, buses will not serve the Bus Station, but instead will operate a one-way loop via the High Street and ASDA, to provide convenient links for those travelling to and from Bingham and Barrowby Gate.

Service 93 will generally operate an hourly off-peak frequency Mon-Fri with a small number of additional journeys at peak times. On Saturdays five return journeys will operate between 08:50 and 16:30.

All journeys will be operated with Vectare's EVM Citylines. These brand-new executive buses provide low floor access, leather seats, air conditioning and USB charging points. Each vehicle is fully wheelchair accessible.
